

MDF

The base for all Stylepads is the same - black MDF: Type MDF-HLS, in accordance with EN 622-5.

The MDF is used in service class 2 (restrictions in temperature and ambient humidity) and can be used in biological hazard classes 1 and 2 of EN 335-3.

It is important for customers to ensure that Stylepads are protected from any direct contact with water. MDF may experience minimal expansion and swelling if kept in a space subject to high humidity.

The MDF used in our Stylepads is responsible for just low formaldehyde emissions (Class E1) and is supplied with a PEFC, FSC or FSC Controlled Wood certificate.
